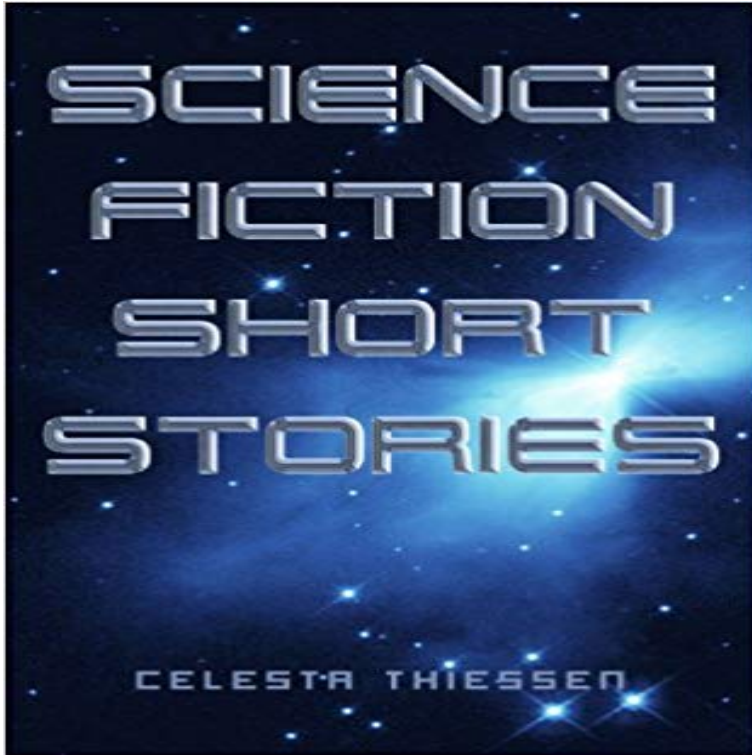


Science Fiction Short Stories
