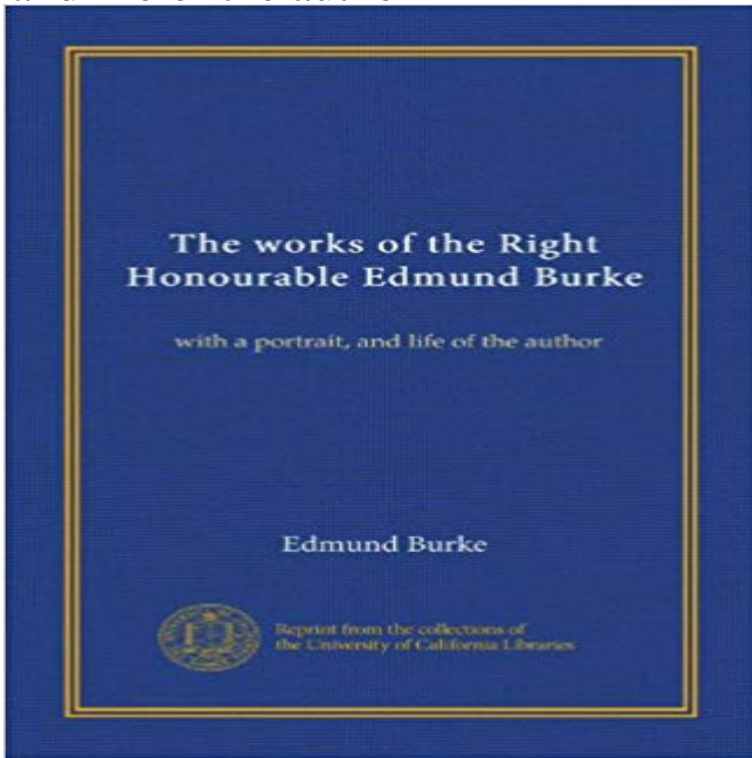


The works of the Right Honourable Edmund Burke (v.3): with a portrait, and life of the author
