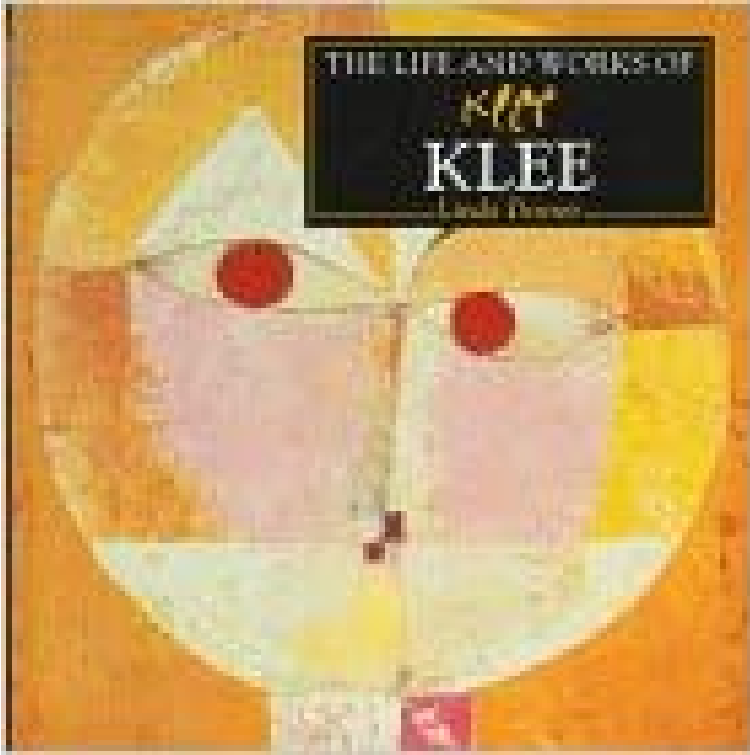


## The Life and Works of Klee (Worlds Greatest Artists Series)
