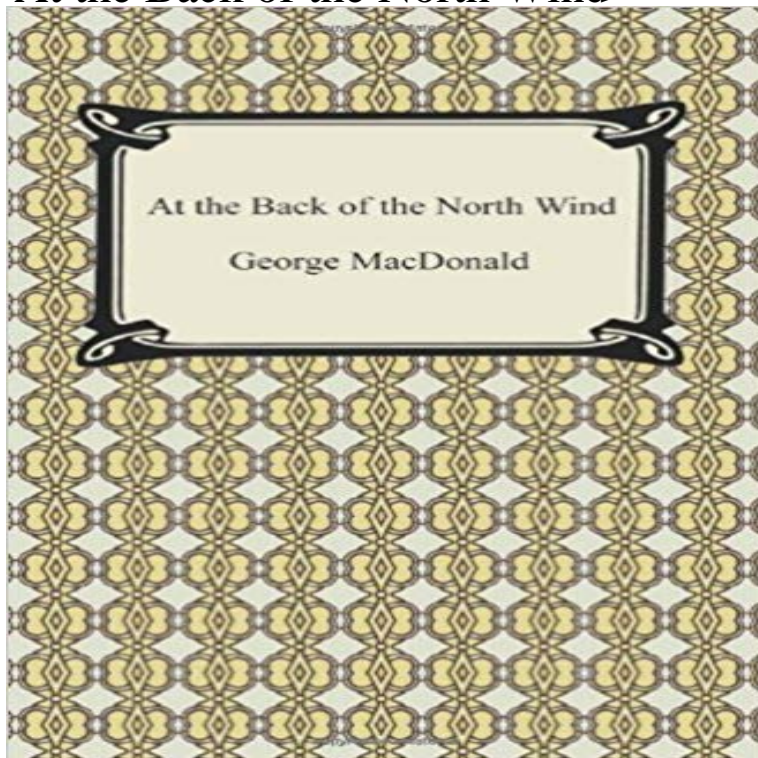


At the Back of the North Wind
