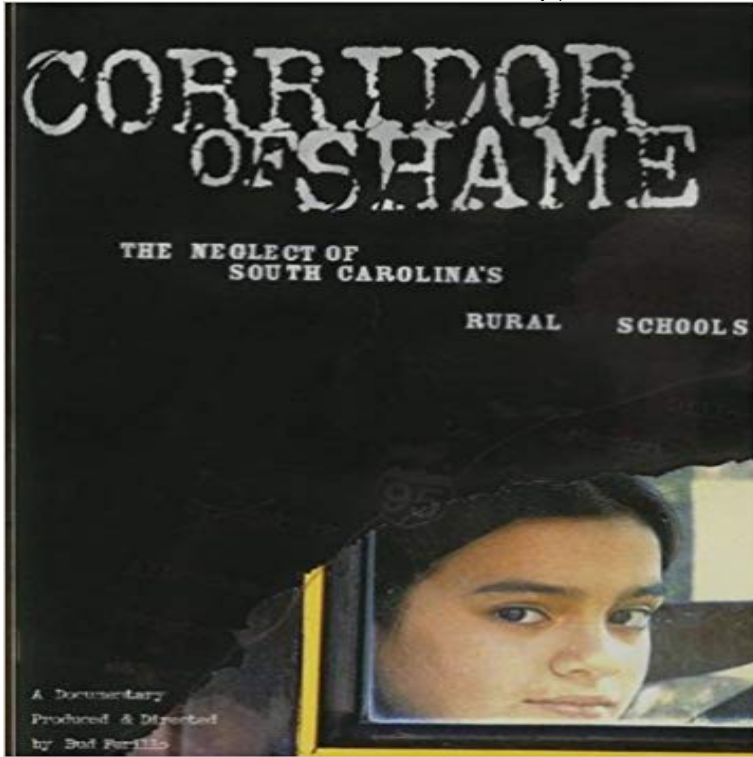


Corridor of Shame: The Neglect of South Carolina's Rural Schools
