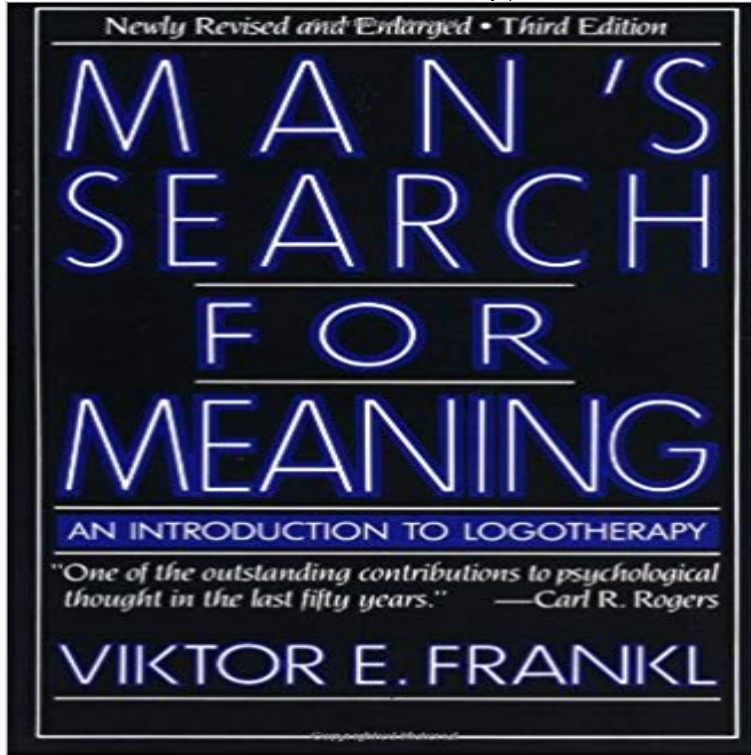


Mans Search for Meaning: An Introduction to Logotherapy
