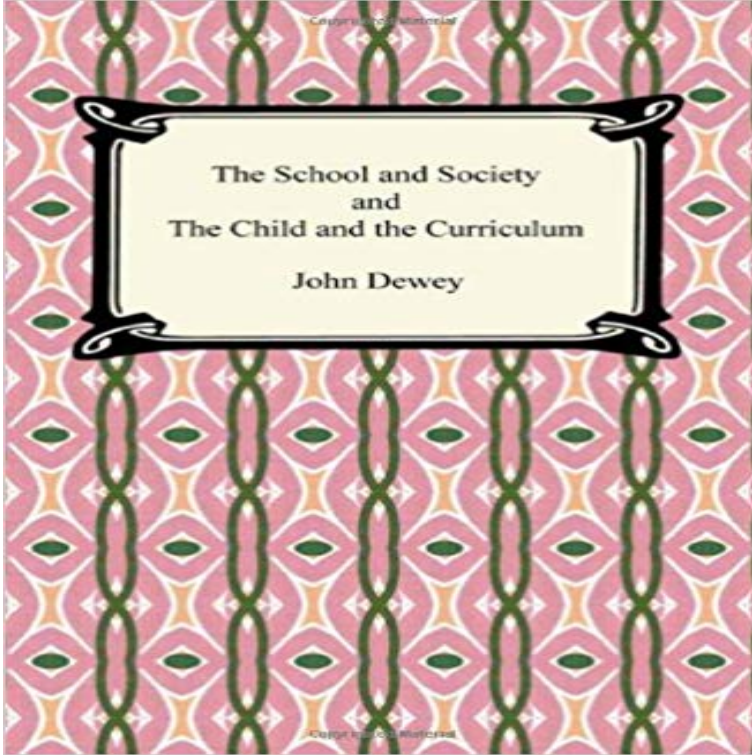


The School and Society and the Child and the Curriculum

Furthermore, he has become known as one of the founders of the philosophy of pragmatism and functional psychology.
