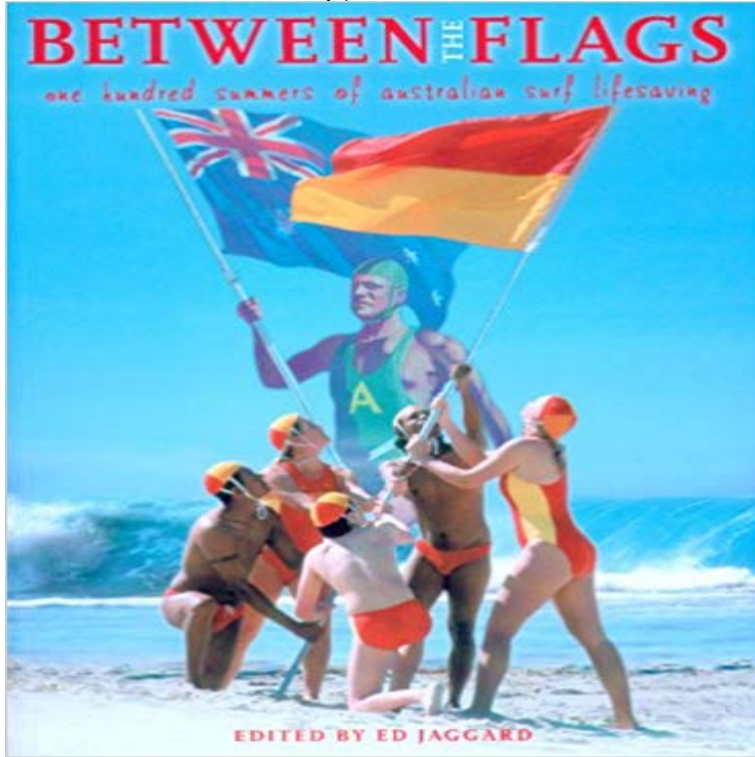


# Between the Flags: One Hundred Years of Australian Surf Lifesaving
