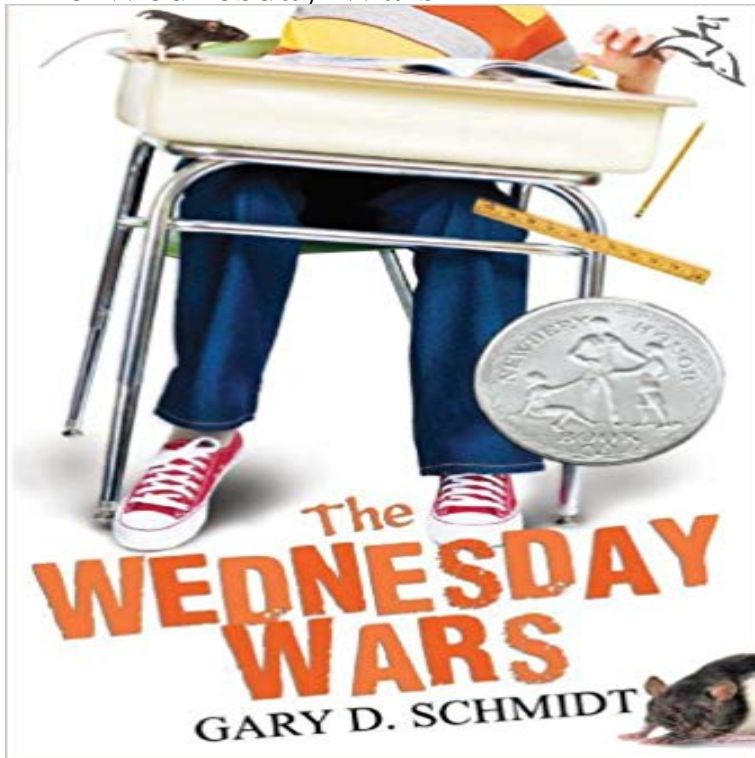


The Wednesday Wars
