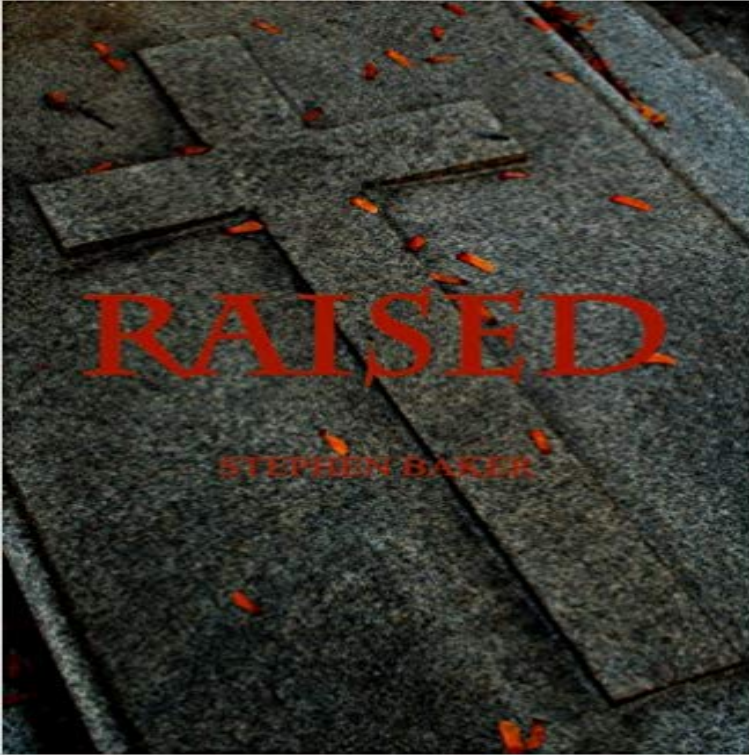


## Raised (Theological Fiction Book 1)
