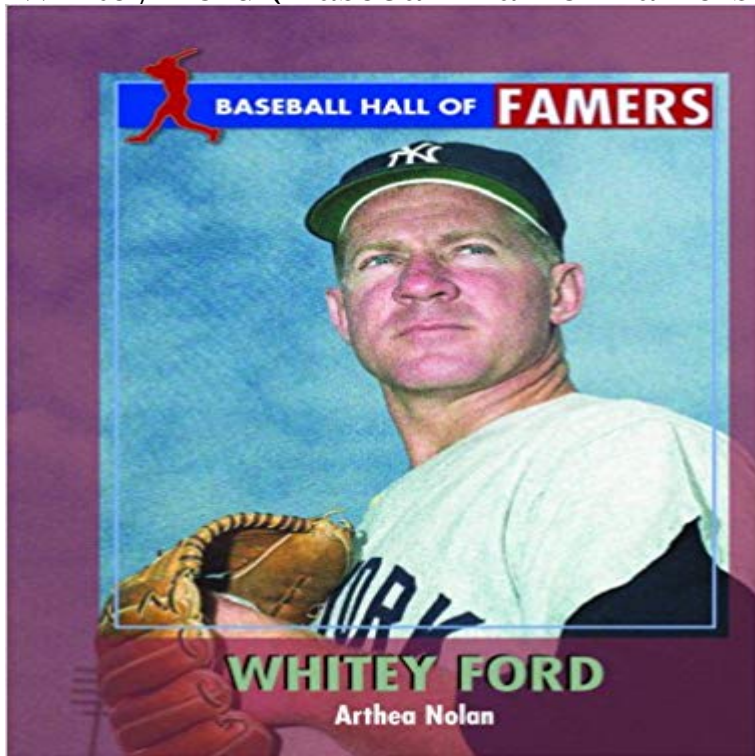


Whitey Ford (Baseball Hall of Famers)
